

# **Technological Transformations In Fisheries**

India is the largest fish producing country, contributing 8 percent to the global fish production and ranks second in aquaculture production. This sector stands as a significant component of the economy recognized as a powerful generator of income and employment. This sector serves as a source of livelihood, employment and entrepreneurship for fishermen and fish farmers with additional employment opportunities. In the 21<sup>st</sup> century, the fisheries industry is undergoing a profound transformation driven by technological advancements.

#### **Global Fisheries Conference India 2023**

On the occasion of World fisheries Day the ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India organized the first edition of Global Fisheries Conference 2023 in Gujarat which concluded on 22<sup>nd</sup> November with a resounding call for technological innovation and collaboration to invigorate India's fisheries sector. The conference marked a significant milestone in fostering progress and sustainability in India's fisheries landscape.

#### **Latest Technology and Trends**

- Aquaculture Automation: Automation technologies are revolutionising aquaculture by improving precision and reducing manual labour.
- Remote Sensing and Satellite Technology: They provide real-time data on ocean conditions, fish migration patterns and environmental changes.
- Fisheries Robotics: Autonomous underwater vehicles (AUVs) and remotely operated vehicles (ROVs) are increasingly used for tasks such as fish population surveys, habitat mapping and underwater inspections.
- Block chain for Traceability: It is being employed to establish transparent and traceable supply chains in the fisheries industry.
- Genomic Tools for Aquatic Species: Advances in genomics are aiding in the selective breeding of fish for desired traits such as growth rate, disease resistance and nutritional content.

#### Scope of Fisheries and Fishing Technology Courses and Eligibility

Undergraduate and post graduate courses encompass a diverse range of subjects including the study of fishes, ecosystems, diseases and their nutrition. The course serves as a scholarly exploration into the multifaceted world of aquaculture, incorporating disciplines such as breeding, genetics, farming and nutrition. Within the curriculum, students engage with the nuances of fishing processing, covering aspects like curing, canning, freezing, value addition by-products and waste utilization, quality assurance and certification. Also the programme explores fisheries microbiology and fisheries biochemistry. Fisheries resource management is a focal point addressing topics such as biology, anatomy, taxonomy, physiology and population dynamics. The fisheries environment is thoroughly investigated, drawing from oceanography, limnology, ecology, biodiversity and aquatic pollution studies. Fishing technology encompasses craft engineering, navigation, seamanship and marine engines. The curriculum also extends to fisheries economics and management.

Admission to the BSc. Fisheries program typically involves clearing entrance exams conducted by colleges and universities after Plus two in Science stream.

## **Current Affairs**

India has nominated the "Maratha Military Landscapes of India" for the UNESCO World Heritage List in 2024-25. The sites showcase the strategic military capabilities of the Maratha Empire between the 17th & 19th centuries. They were developed under Maratha ruler Shivaji Maharaj from 1670CE, continuing through subsequent rulers until 1818.

The inaugural India-Saudi Arabia joint military exercise 'SADA TANSEEQ' commenced on January 29th in Rajasthan. The aim is to develop interoperability, camaraderie and friendship between the troops.

On January 26th, 2024, Alabama used **nitrogen hypoxia** to execute a death row inmate for the first time, marking the debut of a controversial and risky method in US.

Researchers from the National Bureau of Fish Genetic Resources (NBFGR) have discovered **two new species of Congrid eels from the coasts of Tamil Nadu and Kerala.**The eel found in the <u>Gulf of Mannar</u> has been named Ariosoma kannani, honoring the late Prof. L Kannan, renowned marine biologist from Annamalai University. The Kerala coast species is called Ariosoma gracile for its morphological traits.

The central government has announced Bharat Ratna for the former Deputy Prime minister L K Advani and late Bihar leader Karpoori Thakur in his birth centenary year. Bharat Ratna has been conferred upon 50 individuals to date. The award was established in 1954.

The National Highways Authority of India has started a 'One Vehicle, One FASTag' initiative. This aims to enhance Electronic Toll Collection (ETC) efficiency and improve traffic movement at toll plazas. NHAI took this decision after increased cases of multiple tags per vehicle and KYC violations.

Scientists have uncovered the **most ancient** skin fossil, dated to about 286 million years old. The textured fragment exceeds previously known skin fossils by over 21 million years. Microscopic observation revealed detailed skin tissues seen in amniotes—the group including reptiles, birds and mammals.

The central government has identified 30 cities of religious, historical, and tourism significance across India for survey and rehabilitation of adults and children engaged in begging to make these spaces free of beggary by 2026. This outreach in 30 cities is being implemented under the "Support for Marginalized Individuals for Livelihood and Enterprises" (SMILE) scheme by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment.

The military regimes ruling the 3 Sahelian nations—Burkina Faso, Mali and Niger have announced their immediate withdrawal from the Economic Community of West African States which is a regional political and economic union established on 28 May 1975 through the Treaty of Lagos. The surprise exit is being called a "sovereign decision" taken without delay.

The Similipal kai chutney, made with red weaver ants by the tribal people of Odisha's Mayurbhanj district, received a geographical indication (GI) tag on January 2nd, 2024. The savory ant chutney is renowned in the region for its nutritional and medicinal properties.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi recently announced the 'Pradhan Mantri Suryodaya Yojana', a new government scheme to promote rooftop solar power systems which aims to boost India's renewable energy goals and reduce electricity bills for households.

On January 5th, 2024 India's Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), launched a new integrated **web portal by ERNET India.** The portal offers several domain name and website services tailored for educational institutes
